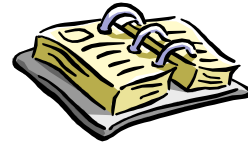

Women in the Gospel of Luke and the Acts of the Apostles, with Joshua Yoder

The Gospel of Luke and its companion book Acts is often considered the most women-friendly of all the New Testament writings. This class will look at how women are portrayed in these two books, drawing from recent biblical scholarship and methods of interpretation. This class will be especially interesting to parents, as our newest Bible Journeys rotation, which begins this morning, will be teaching the stories of five women from the New Testament.
